- 6. Supply **two letters of reference**.
- 7. Compile all the above and send via email or to the address below. Applications must be postmarked/emailed no later than **May 2, 2025.**

- 8. This award is made on the basis of academic promise, character, leadership and involvement with the AJCA.
- 9. The winner(s) will be notified by mail. Upon proof of college registration, a check will be mailed to the appropriate post-secondary institution.
- 10. Winners will not be eligible to reapply for the award.
- 11. A committee will select the scholarship recipients based upon the scoring rubric contained in this packet of information.
